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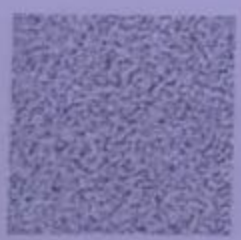

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TRUST DEED

INDIAN TRUST ACT 1882

This Deed of Public Trust Act 1882 is executed on this 06th day of April 2018.

1. The Trust :- "SIRNIA EDUCATIONAL TRUST" is executed by SADEQUE ALI S/O SERAJUL HAQUE, R/O - SIRNIA GOYAGAON -1 GOYALPOKHAR , UTTAR DINAJPUR, WEST BENGAL - 733210, AT PRESENT - PLOT NO- 112, KHASRA NO- 20/24, GROUND FLOOR NAVEEN VIHAR BLOCK-H, RAJEEV NAGAR BEGAMPUR, DELHI - 110086 herein after called the Settler" (Which expression shall, unless excluded by or repugnant to the context, be deemed to include his executors, administrators and representatives) of the one part and

1. Hereinafter jointly referred to as "trustees" (which expression shall, unless excluded or repugnant to the context, be deemed to include the trustee or trustees for the time being of these presents and their successors in office) of the other part. And whereas if the trustees desire to co-opt other eminent personalities as trustees for betterment of trust, they can co-opt but the total number of trustees shall not be more than twelve. And whereas if any vacancy made in Board of trustees these vacancy can be fulfilled by Co-option. Whereas the Settler is desirous of establishing a trust for public charitable objects. And whereas the trustees have, at the request of the Settler, agreed to act as the first trustees of these presents as testified their being parties to and executing these presents. And whereas it is necessary to declare the aims and objects of the public charitable trust, being constituted under these presents.

3. Now this indenture witness as follows:

That, in order to effectuate his aforesaid desire, the Settler has set apart and handed over to the trustees, a sum of Rs. 3,100 **Three Thousand One Hundred Only** (hereinafter called the "Trust Fund" which expression shall include cash and any other property of investments of any kind whatsoever into which the same or any part thereof might be converted, invested or varied from time to time which may be acquired by the trustees or may come to their hands by virtue of these presents or by operation of law or otherwise howsoever in relation to these presents), and the trustees shall hold and stand possessed of the same upon the trust subject to the powers, provisions, agreements and declarations hereinafter contained.

That the name of the trust shall be "SIRNIA EDUCATIONAL TRUST"

Registered Office will be: - PLOT NO- 112, KHASRA NO- 20/24, GROUND FLOOR NAVEEN VIHAR BLOCK- H, RAJEEV NAGAR BEGAMPUR DELHI - 110086,

3. That the objects for which this trust is established are:

- [A.] To promote the concept of provisions for Urban-Rural amenities (PURA), knowledge center, employment generation schemes etc., as envision.

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- [B.] To undertake, organize, investigate, participate, sponsor, the human right Programmers including awakening of human rights, preservation of fundamental rights, protection & safeguards to the victims of human rights violations, for the freedom, dignity and peace of the people. Also, undertake study, research, publications, treaties with national and international institutions and award programmers, for the effective implementation of Human Rights.
- [C.] To set motion and play a proactive role in giving direction for a quiet social movement/revolution for socio-economical, educational, cultural, scientific, technical, financial, ethical prosperity and take spearheaded initiative to spread the gain or prosperity in the benefit of throughout masses of world of living creature.
- [D.] To organize, promote, undertake, sponsor, carry-out, all programmers for the benefit of naturally-challenged person, schedule caste, Schedule tribes, people under poverty line, old-aged, widow, and down trodden irrespective of caste, creed, sex and religion.
- [E.] Be Organization will work for the welfare of minorities and down trodden people.

In the field of Human Resource Development: -

- a) To establish, develop, maintain schools, colleges, libraries, universities, laboratories, skill development centers, competition, preparation centers, yoga and spiritual centers, sports training centers, vocational training centers, research and other institutions for the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge among the public in general.
- b) To establish, maintain and run studentship, scholarship and award program me and render other kind of aid to students including supply of study materials, books, stipend, medals and other incentives.
- c) To organize program for the promotions of pre-primary education, non-formal education, computer & information technologies, leadership development, techno-entrepreneurship development educational, infrastructure research and development, socio-scientific research. And give franchise in block level and assist them with books and teachers .
- d) Publish study-materials, magazine, books, information materials, journals, produce film, T.V. serials, documentaries, audio-video cassettes on burning social, educational and scientific issues.

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- g) And to participate in all emerging issues, whenever occurs on the national and/or international arena and to do all such other lawful acts deeds and things as incidental and conducive to the attainment of the objects or any one of them.
- h) To acquire, hold, transfer, mortgage, lease out and dispose of and otherwise deal with property of the trustee in any manner whatsoever and get loan for the fulfillment of objective of the trustee.
- i) To undertake, carryout, promote, sponsor, discharge, full fill, participate, collaborate, manage or organize the programmers with people's co-operation, national and international Government and Non Government agencies and to carry out all necessary acts for the achievement of the objectives.
- j) All the incomes, earnings, movable/immovable properties of the Trustee shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its Aims and Objects only as set forth in the deed of the Trustee and no profit thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of Dividends, bonus, profits or in any manner whatsoever to the present or the past member of the Trustee or to any person claiming through any one or more of the present or the past members. No members of the Trustee shall have any personal claim on any movable or immovable properties of the Trustee or make any profits, whatsoever, by virtue of his membership.
- k) To accept loan, Grant-in-aid, donation (either in cash or kind), subsidy or other assistance lawfully, either from National and / or International agencies for the attainment of the objective of the trustee.
- l) The Had Branch Office:- SIRNIA P.O GOAGAON P.S GOALPOKHAR DIST- UTTAR DINAJPUR, WEST BENGAL – 733208, and/or at such other place or places as the trustees may decide from time to time. The area of operation of the Trust shall be all over India
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4. All the activities shall be Non Profitable and shall be done on 'No Profit-No Loss' basis.
5. All the incomes, earnings, movable/immovable properties of the trust shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its Aims and Objects only as set forth in the deed of the trust and no profit thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profits or in any manner whatsoever to the present or the past member of the trust or to any person claiming through any one or more of the present or the past members. No members of the trust shall have any personal claim

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on any movable or immovable properties of the trust or make any profits, whatsoever, by virtue of his membership.

6. That the Trust Fund may be augmented by the income from the initial fund and also by donations and other contribution from time to time
7. That the Trust Fund shall not be applied for any purpose other than those specified in Para 3 herein above unless the other objects added to the trust objectives.
8. That the Trustees shall always maintain proper accounts of the Trust, which shall be kept at the office of the trust.
9. Subject to the Provisions of Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time, the Trustees will keep the Trust fund or such portion thereof, as they may, in their absolute discretion, think fit and proper, without being answerable or accountable to the beneficiaries or any other party for any loss invested in such shares, stock, securities and debentures of acquisition or construction of any immovable property including buildings and/or in the purchase and acquisition or mortgage by way of fresh charge on any immovable property in India, of free-hold or leasehold tenure, and may deposit the amounts with any scheduled Bank, Company or Private firm or Individual on such terms and conditions as they think fit, In the matter of investment of Trust funds, the provisions of section 20 of the Indian Trust Act shall apply; in the event of Trustees purchasing any immovable property or properties or advancing moneys or mortgage, they shall be entitled to accept such title or evidence of title as they shall think fit in their absolute and uncontrolled discretion. The Trustees shall have power, if any deed it in their absolute discretion to sell the Trust Fund or any part thereof and any such immovable property purchased by them under the power aforesaid and any other shares, securities, etc. and stand possessed of the money to arise from such sale upon after paying there out the expenses pertaining to such sale upon the Trusts and with the subject to powers and provision including all the posers contained by and under these presents declared and contained concerning the Trust Fund which or the proceeds thereof, shall have laid out in purchase of property or properties as have laid out in purchase of property or properties as aforesaid or such of them as shall be then subsisting and capable of taking effect.

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10. That for the furtherance of the objects of the Trust, the trustees shall have the following powers:

- (i) To accept any donation, contribution grant or subscription in cash or in kind, from any person(s) body of persons or trust, with or without conditions.
- (ii) To apply the whole or any part of the income of the Trust, or the trust fund or accumulations thereto, to any one or more of the objects of the trust, as the trustees may, in their discretion, deem fit from time to time.
- (iii) To sell, dispose of, alienate or otherwise deal with any property comprising the Trust Fund.
- (iv) To open account in the name of the Trust, with a Bank or Banks, to operate such account and to give instructions to the Bank and to provide for opening and operation of such account by one or more of the Trustees or by an agent appointed by the Trustees.
- (v) To adjust, settle, compromise, compound refers to arbitration, all actions. Suits claims, demands and proceedings regarding the Trust Fund.
- (vi) To engage or make provision for the engagement of any person (including all or any of the Trustees and committees or administrator or managing Trustees or otherwise) for the purpose of the administration of the Trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulation as the Trustees may prescribe and also to engage or provide for the engagement.
- (vii) To make, vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the Trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and/or running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the Trust.
- (viii) To start, abolish, discontinue and restart any charity of charitable institutions for the benefit of general public and to impose any conditions to any subscription or donation made by them.
- (ix) To set apart and/or allocate the whole or a part of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or part thereof for any of the objects of the Trust.
- (x) To join, co-operate or amalgamate this trust with other or others having kindred or allied objects, upon such terms and conditions as the trustees may in their discretion think fit, particularly having regard to and in conformity with the objects and nature of this Trust.

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- (xi) To give aid by way of donations out of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or otherwise, to different charitable institutions, societies, organizations or Trusts in India which may have been established or which may hereinafter be established for the like charitable purposes mentioned in these presents or any of them to enable such Institution, societies, organization or Trustees to start maintain, or carry out such charitable objects.
 - (xii) To settle all accounts and to compromise, abandon, or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings or disputes, claim, demand or things, as deemed proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.
 - (xiii) To borrow money either on the security of any property comprised in the Trust Fund or otherwise for all or any of the purposes of these presents, and it shall be lawful for the Trustee to make such borrowings on payment of such interest and otherwise on such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.
 - (xiv) To apply to the Government, public bodies, urban, local municipal, district and other bodies, corporation, companies, or persons for and to accept grant of money and of aid, donations, gifts, subscriptions, affiliation and other assistance with a view to promote the objects of the Trust and to discuss and negotiate with the Government Departments, public and other bodies corporations, companies or persons, scheme and other work and matters within the objects of the Trust and to put to any proper condition upon which such grants and other payments may be made.
 - (xv) To take over or amalgamate with any other charitable trust, trustee, association, or institution with similar objects.
 - (xvi) To take over, acquire, manage, control or aid any existing institution or institutions having objects either wholly or in part similar to the objects of this Trust and on such terms and conditions as may be thought expedient.
 - (xvii) To purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagement of any or more of the trusts, societies, institutions or associations with which this Trust is authorized to amalgamate.
11. The Trustees shall be accountable only for such money, and funds, which will actually come into their hands.

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12. The Trustees will not be entitled to receive any remuneration, but the Trustee may reimburse themselves all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with the Trust or their duties relating thereto.
13. The managing Trustee for the time being will be at liberty to appoint additional Trustee within the number mentioned above for such period or on such terms as to retirement and re-appointment as the trustees for the time being consider proper.
14. A person shall cease to be a Trustee either:
 - If he without leave of absence does not attend three consecutive meetings of the Trustees or for one calendar year, whichever is longer, or
 - If he is requested to resign by 3/4th or as near thereto as possible of the remaining trustees.
15. Every Trustee will be at liberty to resign on giving one month's notice of his intention to do so.

The Trustees may from time to time frame rules for the conduct and regulations of the meetings of trustees. In the absence of such regulations:

 - (a) Three trustees shall form a quorum for a meeting of the Trustees.
 - (b) All matters will be decided by 3/4th majority by the Trustees.
 - (c) Resolution passed without any meeting of the Trustees but by circulation thereof and evidenced in writing under the hands of 3/4th of the trustees shall be as valid and effectual as a Resolution duly passed at a meeting of Trustees.
16. The Trustees shall have the power to determine in case of doubt whether any money or property shall for the purpose of the charity be considered as capital or income and whether out of income or capital any expenses or outgoing ought to be paid or borne and every such determination shall be binding and conclusive provided that nothing contained shall be deemed to authorize the Trustees to spend the income or corpus of the Trust for any purpose not authorized by these presents.
17. The accounting year of the Trust shall be the financial year ending on 31ST March every year.
18. The Trust and the Trust funds shall be irrevocable for all the times.
19. It is expressly declared that no part of the Trust property or its income or any accretion thereto shall be applied for any purpose outside India or for any purpose which is not a charitable purpose in law, and all provisions hereof shall be construed accordingly.

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20. POWER & FUNCTION OF THE OFFICE BEARER

TRUSTEE:

The President shall preside at all meetings of the Managing Trustee and of the trustee, when he is present and shall exercise such other powers as are conferred upon him by these rules. The President may call for an emergency meeting through President Signed notice in a shorter notice. The decision of President that a resolution has been carried or lost shall be conclusive, unless such a decision is challenged and a poll is demanded; on poll being demanded, the same shall be taken in such manner as the President may in discretion determine. In case of a tie the President shall have a second or casting vote.

- a) He shall be convener of all the meetings and without his signature on the notice of meetings no meetings will be valid.
- b) It shall be his duty to see that the resolution at the respective meeting are implemented and give to effect to timely.
- c) In the absence of Secretary, the President will look after all powers conferred on Secretary.

TRUSTEE:

- a) He shall be in charge of the office and shall be responsible to general body in all matters. He will contract in all ways and means of the position of the association and shall have right to improve it.
- b) Secretary shall produce the accounts of the trustee before Managing Trustee for approval.
- c) Secretary will produce the expenditure of the trustee before the Managing Trustee for approval.
- d) Secretary shall appoint, suspend, discharge, fix the salary, make payment of the employees of the institution and conducted by the trustee on behalf of the Managing Trustee.
- e) In the absence of president, the Secretary will look after all powers conferred on President.

TRUSTEE:

- a) The treasurer will act under the direction of the committee.
- b) Any amount exceeding Rs. 10000/- which is not required for immediate use shall be paid into such bank or banks as may be approved or by the committee. The treasurer shall ordinarily receive all payments and disburse the amount passed by the president/Secretary and shall maintain proper books of accounts.
- c) Treasurer shall maintain the account in proper and prescribed form. He shall deposit and withdraw the amount of the trust in the bank or in the post office with the signatures of any two of the secretary, president or treasurer.

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21. MEMBERSHIP:

- (A) The membership of the trust shall be opened to all men and women who have attained the age of 21 years and subscription and fees and must be citizen of India.
- (B) An application for membership shall be made in the prescribe form to the PRESIDENT /SECRETARY of the board of management and the paid shall take a decision in the matter of his / her admission to membership and their decision shall be final.
- (C) The PRESIDENT /SECRETARY shall have the right to refuse membership without assigning any reason for such rejection.

2. REGISTER OF MEMBERSHIP:

A register is the form prescribed by the board of management will be with their age, occupation and full address which will be seen in the office during office hours.

3. CATEGORIES OF MEMBERSHIP:

There shall be three kinds of members:

- (a) General member
- (b) Patron member
- (c) Honorary member
- (d) GENERAL MEMBER: Will be he/ she who applied for membership in the prescribed form along with the application fees of Rs 500/= and annual subscription of Rs 5000/= only. Which may be changed by time to time with the consent of President /secretary.
- (e) PATRON MEMBER: Will be he/she who contributes Rs.5,000/= annually to the fund of the trust and applies for the same with a fee of Rs 500/= .
- (f) HONORARY MEMBER: Will be those who are nominated by the board of management as such in recognition of their valuable services to the cause of whole humanity of one adopted by the board of management for advising the members. Such member will not be required to make any contribution to the fund the trust, out may be invited to take part in the meeting of the board of management, but shall have no voting rights.

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ii. In the field of Health & Family welfare: -

- a) To undertake, establish, assist, organize or conduct the program me of research, management and infrastructure development in the field of health & family welfare.
- b) To establish, organize, run or maintain Hospital, Nursing Home, Care and Care Centers, Medical education and research center in state-of-the-art.
- c) To undertake, organize, establish or run the medical education center, college and research center.
- d) To undertake awareness, prevention, surveillance, screening, management health systems and research programmers on Maternal and Child survival, communicable diseases like Malaria, Hepatitis, Leprosy, Meningitis, HIV/AIDS, STD, T.B., Dengue, non-Communicable diseases like Cancer, Heart Diseases, Respiratory Diseases, Diabetes, Mellitus, and Injuries etc. Health Insurance, Population control etc.
- e) To establish and run Drug De-addiction center and undertake rehabilitation program me for drug-abuse. Also organise awareness program me for the control of drug-menace and abuse.

iii. In the field of Agriculture and allied Industries Development: -

- a) To conduct and undertake the research of technologies advancement, productivity enhancement, cost effectiveness technologies and methodologies in the field of agriculture, allied industries, cottage industries, veterinary and co-operatives.
- b) To conduct awareness and exposition program me of appropriate and low cost technologies agriculture.
- c) Conduct the programmers to ensure nutrition security, safe food processing and standardization.
- d) To conduct intensive research in the field of fisheries, aquaculture, poultry, dairying, livestock, sheep & goat, horticulture, floriculture, aromatic & medicinal plants, fruits, hybrid vegetables, mushroom etc. and land the benefit of research.
- e) To carryout study, research and development activities for water management, irrigation, fertilizer, farm mechanism, bio-technology, integrated pest management method.
- f) To make the market-mechanism most favorable to the farmers. To develop the infrastructure for the easy and safe delivery of agro-products. Also establish and run financial institution for the benefit of agriculture and allied industries-related people.
- g) To form and patronize self help group (S.H.G.) for the promotion of micro-credit and optimum financial benefit to the rural people.

- a) To promote education, training and research programmes in Rural Management and generate a Human Resource Force to settle the needs of people in rural areas.
- b) To organize, conduct, sponsor, the intensive programme on Rural housing, Rural finance, Marketing mechanism infrastructure development, Cottage & small scale industries development, co-operative and cooperation, Integrated wasteland Development, Technology Development Extension and training programme, Investment Promotion Schemes for the promotion of rural infrastructure, watershed and water management and unutilized resource development programme, welfare and strengthening programme for marginal and underprivileged farmers, promotion of cost effective technologies, rural sanitation including low-cost latrines.
- c) To work, associate and/or act as implementing agency in Swarn Jayanti Gram Swarozgar Yojana, Samagra Awas Yojana and other developmental programme run by Government/agencies.

VI. In the field of Social Justice & Empowerment: -

- a) To carry out all the programmes for the relief, rehabilitation, welfare and development of women in destitute, old-aged, handicapped, street children and child labour, widow, orphan, beggar, sex-worker, schedule caste, schedule tribes, backward and other under privileged people.

VIII. In the field of Youth Affairs and Sports: -

- a) To carry out all the programmers'/projects for the awakening of national integration, communal harmony, co-operation and co-operative behavior attitude development, moral and social habit development in the youth and to ensure participation in the development of nation and humanity.
- b) To organize and install infrastructure for the promotion of sports, yoga, meditation among youths.

IX. In the field of Science & Technologies and Communication & Information Technologies:

- a) To carry out all the programmers' science & Technology and communication Information Technology for popularization, use and inculcation of scientific temper among the people. Also ensure the use of technologies in the field of rural development, appropriate technology, rural technologies, environment and ecology, non-conventional energy, formal education, computer education etc.
- b) To organize the program me and set-up infrastructure, for the creation of techno-entrepreneurship through structured training programmers and other facilitating mechanisms.
- c) To promote research development and adaptation of science and technology for improving quality of life of traditional artisans, landless lab our and weaker section.

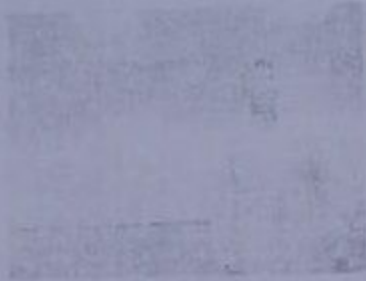

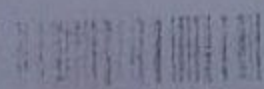
